Hydrotherapy

THERAPY

Water is recognized as a significant factor in treating those with severe injuries. The heated water relaxes muscles, eases pain, and enables strengthening exercises to improve mobility. Each Centre has specially-heated swimming pools as well as dedicated hydrotherapy pools where treatments are administered by trained professionals.

Physical Therapy

Physical therapists and medical personnel implement specialized therapeutic programs using the most up-to-date knowledge and skills to benefit our members.

Rehabilitative Therapy

Disabled members, including those who have lost limbs, or are living with blindness, paraplegia, quadriplegia, or a range of other disabilities that require individualized care, are treated in each Centre's rehabilitative therapy wing.

Academic and Athletic Scholarships

As those injured in the line of duty find life plans suddenly derailed, academic and athletic scholarships assist them in determining new directions and regaining independence.



SUPPORT

Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) Support Groups

With Beit Halochem Canada funding, a support group was founded at Jerusalem's Centre to assist those suffering from PTSD. Recognizing that a veteran's mental trauma affects the entire family, a spouses' support group was also established. This vital program has now expanded to other Centres.

Sports Therapy

Cycling - including hand bike and tandem, wheelchair basketball, tennis, volleyball, swimming, archery, table tennis, gym, and Pilates are some of the many rehabilitative sports and activities that improve our members' strength and enhance their self-esteem.

Paralympic Games / International Competitions

Beit Halochem's athletes, benefiting from specialized coaching and equipment, have achieved remarkable success at the Paralympics and other international competitions.

Family-Oriented programming

Knowing that everyone is affected by the veteran's injury, programs engaging the entire family complement the member's therapy. All enjoy the Centres' welcoming atmosphere and activities that enrich and enhance family life.



CULTURE

Creative/Cultural Activities

Photography, ceramics, painting, sculpture, music, carpentry, computer, and language classes are among the many programs available to our injured members and their families.

Kids of Courage

Beit Halochem Canada brings 45 Bar and Bat Mitzvah-aged children of severely disabled Israeli veterans to Canada to enjoy a summer with Canadian children their age. Each year, this overnight camp experience provides a break from the reality of being children of injured parents.
